

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S
CORRECTIONS TO PREHEARING STATEMENT**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), subsequent to the filing of its Prehearing Statement on October 26, 2000 has determined that the following corrections should be made to the company's Prehearing Statement:

1. On Issue 2 the appropriate estimated fuel adjustment true-up amount for the period January 2000 through December 2000 should be changed from \$42,721,321 underrecovery to \$34,058,660 underrecovery. The new amount is the net of the \$42,721,321 underrecovery reflected in response to Issue 3 and the \$8,662,661 underrecovery that was approved in the mid-course correction order, Order No. PSC-00-1081-PCO-EI, referred to in response to Issue 1.

2. The \$1,997,239 overrecovery referenced in response to Issue 17 should be changed to \$2,072,182 overrecovery. The corrected amount is the net of the \$1,977,239 overrecovery referenced in response to Issue 18 and the underrecovery of \$94,943 approved in the mid-course correction order, Order No. PSC-00-1081-PCO-EI, referred in response to Issue 16.


3. The jurisdictional separation factor for capacity revenues of 97.40171% referred to in Tampa Electric's response to Issue 20 should be changed to 95.93916%. The separation factor initially supplied was taken from an incorrect calculation in the company's spreadsheets.

4. The projected capacity cost recovery factor of 0.202 cents per KWH referred to in Tampa Electric's Statement of Basic Position and its response to Issue 21 should be changed to 0.199 cents per KWH. This correction is a carry over of the correction made to Tampa Electric's jurisdictional separation factor in its response to Issue 20.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric submits the foregoing corrections to its Prehearing Statement in the above proceeding.

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
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
