Recommendation: Yes. Southwestern Bell Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Southwestern Bell Long Distance d/b/a Nevada Bell Long Distance d/b/a Pacific Bell Long Distance d/b/a SBC Long Distance should be relieved of the bond requirement of Rule 25-24.490(2), Florida Administrative Code, as provided in the rule.
