Dear Ms. Bayo:

Pursuant to a letter dated November 1, 2000 from staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission"), ATI Telecom, Inc. ("ATI") hereby files its 1999 Alternative Local Exchange Company Regulatory Assessment Fee Return and check payable to the Commission in the amount of \$67.50 in the above captioned proceeding. In addition, the following settlement is offered on behalf of ATI.

The Commission's letter indicates that ATI failed to timely remit its 1999 regulatory assessment fee ("RAF") by January 30th of this year and that a show cause order canceling ATI's certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Florida would issue if the RAF was not paid (with penalties and interest) and this settlement offer not submitted. ATI wishes to put this matter behind it without the expenditure of additional resources for a hearing or other legal process. ATI also recognizes that the Commission's resources are better devoted to more important matters. Accordingly, ATI is willing to offer a voluntary settlement or payment of \$500 to the State of Florida to resolve this matter. ATI respectfully requests that any order or ruling by the Commission in this matter reflect that 1) the payment is a voluntary settlement (and not reflect that it is a fine); and 2) no determination as to fault or violation is being made.

As indicated above, ATI has submitted the required RAF pursuant to the Commission's letter (\$67.50 - \$50 RAF, \$12.50 penalty and \$5.00 interest). In addition, ATI has taken the

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necessary steps to prevent future late payment of the RAF. ATI takes its obligations as a certificated carrier very seriously and places a high degree of importance on responding to all regulatory notices on a timely basis.
