

I am in receipt of the Public Service Commission letter with regard to the above referenced Docket No. The letter indicates that we have not paid regulatory assessment fees for 1999.

I have enclosed check number 10044542 in the amount of \$73.50 for payment of the 1999 assessment, associated penalty, and interest. We request that the Florida Public Service Commission not revoke our certificate of authority.

The reason for the confusion in making timely filing to the Commission is due to the purchase of IdealDial Corporation by RMI.Net. The purchase of IdealDial occurred June 13, 1999. At the time the filing was due, our Vice President of Operations left the company. We thought that this individual had made the necessary filing to the Florida Commission.

We now have two staff attorneys, and compliance officer who will make certain that all necessary filings are accurate, and assessments are reported and paid when due. We would ask for a waiver of the fine, due to the unusual circumstances. However, if that is not possible, I would like to propose a settlement of \$100.00 for our error.
