3. Is the proposed conversion of the Brandy Branch combustion turbines to combined cycle the most cost effective alternative available to JEA?

4. Are there any conservation or demand side management alternatives reasonably available to JEA which would mitigate the need for the conversion of the Brandy Branch combustion turbines to combined cycle?

5. Should the Commission grant a determination of need for the conversion of the Brandy Branch combustion turbines to combined cycle?


