Dear Commissioner Garcia:

I am extremely disappointed that your staff has denied the transfer of Gulf Utility to Gulf Environmental Services, Inc.

The Lee County Board of County Commissioners decided that it was in the public interest to acquire Gulf Utility. To that end, the Lee County Board of County Commissioners established a governmental authority known as Gulf Environmental Services, Inc. Gulf Environmental Services, Inc. was established by appropriate resolutions at public meetings. All of its financing and authority to issue bonds was created by the Lee County Board of County Commissioners. All of the rates of Gulf Environmental Services are set by the Lee County Board of County Commissioners. Lee County may dissolve Gulf Environmental Services, Inc. and absorb its operations into our County system by resolution. We contemplate that having Gulf Environmental Services, Inc. operate the utility system is an interim step to direct operations by the County. We believe that the utility system being operated by Gulf Environmental Services, Inc., is a governmental utility operation. We are indeed disappointed and concerned that your staff does not agree. Your staff's position is an impediment to Lee County's utility acquisition and operation program.

The procedure employed in using a not-for-profit corporation to accomplish the acquisition of Gulf Utility Company, on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, is exactly identical to the procedure employed by the City of Palm Bay in its purchase of General Development Utilities in 1992. The City of Palm Bay set up the Palm Bay Utility Corporation, a Florida not-for-profit corporation, which took title to the assets as an interim measure. Just a couple of years later, the City dissolved Palm Bay Utility Corporation, and merged the assets into the City system. Your Commission issued its Final Order approving that procedure in December of 1992. The same thing happened a couple of years earlier when the City of Kissimmee bought Osceola Services Company. We question why we are being treated differently in this case.



Dear Ms. Holstine:

This letter is in response to your September 22, 1998 E-Mail complaint (copy attached) about the rates being charged by Gulf Environmental Services, Inc. (GES). After a public hearing held on June 9, 1998, an Agreement for Purchase and Sale of Water and Wastewater Assets from Gulf Utility Company (Gulf) to GES was adopted by the Lee County Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Resolution No. 98-03-249. The sale agreement closed in June of 1998 and GES took over operations of the utility under rates established by its Board of Directors which are appointed by the Board of County Commissioners.

Although the Commission does regulate Gulf's rates and charges, GES, as a government-controlled corporation, is exempt from Commission regulation pursuant to Chapter 367.022(2), Florida Statutes. However, instead of filing for transfer of Gulf's certificates to a government-controlled entity, GES filed as a transfer to a governmental authority. Staff will file a recommendation for the Commission's consideration during the November 3, 1998 Agenda Conference, requesting clarification from the Commission on how to handle the filing. Meanwhile, you may wish to direct any complaints about GES's rates to the Board of County Commissioners.

comments: We are extremely upset at the enormous jump in our water rates since GES took over. Our bill for 9/15 was \$91.65. In April and May, our bill was \$77.81. One month we filled a 10,000 gal. pool. One month we had a leak that has since been fixed. Our normal bill averages \$60. This means we are now faced with a 33% jump in our normal rate. I understand this will continue. This enormous jump in the water rate hits the middle-class taxpayer extremely hard, and it outrageous. We can't understand why they have instituted a tiered billing system that is causing such an enormous jump in the bill. Thank you for your attention to the matter of Gulf Environmental Services, Inc.'s rate hikes.
