Dear Commissioner Garcia

I am writing to urge that the Florida PSC consider Fresh Look regulations that would give Internet Service Providers maximum relief from penalties contained in termination clauses of long term contracts that they signed with BellSouth.

In my own case, I signed contracts with BellSouth as an executive of InternetU, an ISP that I co-founded. At that time organizations like ours did not know of impending competition and were attracted by the discounts that BellSouth offered on long term contracts. Now the penalty clauses keep InternetU locked in with BellSouth to the detriment of the business and its customers.

I have personal knowledge of many other ISPs whose businesses are hampered in the same way. I might point out that one of the prime competitors in the marketplace is bellsouth.net, BellSouth's own ISP. It is certainly to their advantage that other ISPs should pay excessive penalties.

I urge the PSC to carefully consider Fresh Look regulations that would create a more competitive environment for all concerned and ultimately benefit Florida consumers and businesses.
