<u>Issue 1</u>: Should Order No. PSC-00-1787-PAA-TC be rendered a Final Order and Docket No. 001037-TC closed?

Recommendation: Yes. The company has not submitted a response to the Commission's Proposed Agency Action Order in compliance with Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code. Therefore, Order No. PSC-00-1787-PAA-TC should be rendered a Final Order. If the company fails to pay in full the required fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, within five business days of the issuance of the Order from this recommendation, Brytel Communications' Certificate No. 5569 should be cancelled effective October 6, 2000, and in accordance with Order No. PSC-00-1787-PAA-TC. Whether or not Brytel Communications pays the required 1999 fees, and penalty and interest charges for 1998 and 1999, this docket should be closed upon expiration of the five business days as no further action by the Commission is required. If Brytel Communications fails to pay the 1999 regulatory assessment fee, plus the 1998 and 1999 statutory penalty and interest charges, the unpaid fees should be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for further collection efforts.
