This letter is written on behalf of Group Long Distance, Inc., a client of TCS, Inc. Group Long Distance, Inc. does business in the state of Florida as an alternative exchange company, as well as an interexchange company. When the time came to file the Regulatory Assessment Fee Return for both services, TCS, Inc. mistakenly entered the same code for both accounts. This was due to the fact that the RAF provided by the Commission was not used.

In January 2000, Group Long Distance, Inc. mailed two checks to the Commission, one in the amount of \$234.84 and the second in the amount of \$100.00. Due to the fact that each RAF had the same company code, the monies where applied to one account. It is Group Long Distance desire to have the payment be applied as follows:

\$234.84 be applied to the company code TI033
\$100.00 be applied to the company code TX143

We have taken steps to prevent this from happening in the future and will only use the forms and returns that are provided by the Commission. Finally, we request that no monetary penalty be assessed due to the extenuating circumstances.
