SUBJECT: CURRENT STATUS OF WATER TREATMENT PLANT DESIGN, PERMITTING, AND ASSOCIATED DISTRIBUTION DESIGN AND PERMITTING - SAN SEBASTIAN WOODS

Dear Pat:

The following is to serve as a status report on the above-mentioned activities associated with utilities development in the San Sebastian Woods subdivision:

- 1. Water Plant Permit 80,000 GPD average daily flow for water plant permitting. Preliminary permitting meeting has been held with DEP. Anticipated official permit submittal to take place January 12, which will include permit application, engineering report, and plant process flow diagram. (Construction plans are approximately 85 percent complete).
- Plant Construction I anticipate plant construction permit issuance in late March 2001. Construction to follow immediately. Construction completion estimated in late 2001.
- 3. Distribution System An estimated 20 percent of the distribution system currently exists. Field and survey work was completed in December 2000 for the remainder of the subdivision's distribution system.
- 4. Plans and Permits for the Distribution System These are anticipated to be submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection in early February 2001—to be permitted concurrently with the water plant. Construction of distribution to commence immediately upon receipt of the DEP permitts.
- 5. Consumptive Use Permit Wells already existing on site for water plant constructed in mid-1980's have been pump tested to ensure capacity demonstrated aquifer drawdown. Permit submitted to St. Johns River Water

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Management District in November 2000. We anticipate permit issuance in late February 2001.
