Re: Approval of an Amendment to the Resale Agreement Negotiated by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and Alternative Telecommunications Services, Inc. d/b/a Second Chance Phone pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996

Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and Alternative Telecommunications Services, Inc. d/b/a Second Chance Phone are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission their amendment to their negotiated agreement for the purchase of BellSouth's telecommunications services for the purpose of resale to end users by Alternative Telecommunications Services, Inc. d/b/a Second Chance Phone. The Commission approved the initial agreement between the companies in Order No. PSC-00-2273-FOF-TP issued November 29, 2000 in Docket 001196-TP. This amendment changes the company name on the agreement.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the amendment to the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and Alternative Telecommunications Services, Inc. d/b/a Second Chance Phone within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. Alternative Telecommunications Service, Inc has changed the name of said business to Alternative Telecommunications Service, Inc d/b/a Second Chance Phone, a Florida corporation. The Resale Agreement is hereby amended to reflect the name change.

2. All of the other provisions of the Resale Agreement, dated May 4, 2000, shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Either or both of the Parties is authorized to submit this Amendment to each Public Service Commission for approval subject to Section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
