MediaOne is authorized by the Commission to provide local exchange service in Florida as an alternative local exchange telecommunications company ("ALEC") pursuant to Certificate No. 4404. As such, MediaOne is subject to the statutes, rules and orders of the Commission and such statutes, rules and orders impact both MediaOne's ability to provide telecommunications services in Florida and MediaOne's ability to compete in Florida.

4. This proceeding will focus on a host of legal, factual and policy issues concerning the delivery of Internet Service Provider-bound traffic, including whether the delivery of such traffic is subject to compensation under Section 251 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and the appropriate intercarrier compensation mechanism for the delivery of such traffic. As an ALEC, MediaOne exchanges traffic with incumbent local exchange companies and other ALECs in order to provide local exchange service. Thus, the Commission's decisions in this proceeding, which are anticipated to have general applicability, affect MediaOne substantial interests, entitling MediaOne to participate with party status as a matter of law.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, MediaOne respectfully requests that it be granted intervention as a full party in this proceeding.
