- RE: Docket No. 001138-WS - Application for amendment of Certificates Nos. 277-W and 223-S to add territory in Seminole County by CWS Communities LP d/b/a Palm Valley.

By this memorandum, we are requesting that the above-referenced docket be reopened for the following reasons:

By Order No. PSC-00-2243-PAA-WS, issued November 27, 2000, and consummated on December 26, 2000, by Order No. PSC-00-2494-CO-WS, the Commission, among other things, approved a new class of service for reclaimed water service to be provided to certain existing home sites, planned home sites, and common areas. It has since come to staff's attention that this service will be provided as a general service, rather than as a residential service. (The service will be provided as a general service to one customer, a mobile home park, which will in turn defide where in the park the reuse lines will run, as opposed to being a residential service provided to specified residential lots within the utility's service area.)

Staff wishes to file a recommendation in the docket to correct the above-described miscommunication and to have the utility's general service tariff sheet approved. (Pursuant to Order No. PSC-00-2243-PAA-WS, staff has the administrative authority to approve the tariff sheet only if it is consistent with the Order. The tariff sheet is not consistent with the Order, since it is for general, rather than residential, reuse service.)
