RESOLUTION NUMBER 99

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN BREEZE PARK, FLORIDA OPPOSING THE PROPOSAL OF THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION STAFF TO ELIMINATE SEVEN-DIGIT DIALING AND REQUIRING TEN-DIGIT DIALING FOR 561 AREA CODE CUSTOMERS

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Ocean Breeze Park, Florida has made the following determinations:

- The Florida Public Service Commission staff has proposed to change telephone
 calls in the Treasure Coast to ten-digit dialing which will also include local
 connections:
- The shortage of numbers available to the telecommunication industry in the Treasure
 Coast is the result of Martin, St. Lucie and Indian River Counties having been
 lumped together with the metropolitan areas of Palm Beach County;
- The residents of Ocean Breeze Park and the citizens of Martin, St. Lucie and Indian River Counties have sought to retain a distinctively less metropolitan lifestyle than counties to the south such as Palm Beach County;
- Requiring the citizens of the Town of Ocean Breeze to use ten-digit dialing for local calls is burdensome, inconvenient and unnecessary;
- If necessary to avoid the change to ten-digit dialing for local calls, the Treasure Coast counties should be given an area code separate from Palm Beach County.
- The slower rate of growth in the Treasure Coast area should eliminate any need for ten-digit dialing for local calls for many years to come.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Ocean Breeze Park, Florida:

 The Town Council strongly opposes the proposal of the Florida Public Service Commission staff to eliminate seven-digit dialing and requiring ten-digit dialing for customers living in the Town and in the Treasure Coast area (Martin, St. Lucie and Indian River Counties).
