ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-01-0158-PAA-TC is hereby amended as specified in the body of this Order. It is further


ORDERED that the 21-day period for protesting the granting of the waiver regarding the above location will commence upon the issuance of this amendatory order. It is further
