Dear Ms. Gerner:

This is a follow up to your recent letter in which you stated that Intraco Systems is not a telecommunications company. In addition, you returned the 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee return and asked the Commission to "adjust" our records.

Your company paid the \$250.00 application fee, applied for and received an alternative local exchange telecommunications certificate, which became effective August 28, 2000. If Intraco Systems wishes to cancel its certificate, it first needs to comply with Rule 25-24.820(2)(a), (b), (c), and (d), Florida Administrative Code, copy attached.

As information, there are two types of cancellation. The first is voluntary and is requested by the certificate holder. The Commission grants voluntary cancellations if a company is in good standing and has no outstanding balance of the Regulatory Assessment Fee. The other is involuntary. This is where the Commission cancels a certificate for a rule violation, such as not paying the Regulatory Assessment Fee. If the Commission cancels a certificate involuntarily, any unpaid fees, including penalty and interest charges, are forwarded to the Comptroller's Office for collection attempts.

The Regulatory Assessment Fee is owed if a certificate is active for any day during a calendar year. Although Intraco Systems may not be a telecommunications company, the Regulatory Assessment Fee is owed for the year 2000. Since we received your letter on December 27, 2000, I will make that date the effective date of the cancellation if Intraco wishes to cancel its certificate and if your letter specifically requesting cancellation and payment for the 2000 fee is postmarked by January 30, 2001. It should be noted that if your payment is postmarked after January 30, penalty and interest charges will apply.

25-24.820 Revocation of a Certificate.

(1) The Commission may on its own motion, after notice and opportunity for hearing, revoke a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:

- (a) Violation of a term or condition under which the authority was originally granted;
- (b) Violation of Commission rule or order;
- (c) Violation of Florida Statute; or
- (d) Violation of a price list standard.

(2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request. Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the required information.

- (a) A statement of intent and date certain to pay regulatory assessment fee.
- (b) A statement of why the certificate is proposed to be canceled.
- (c) A statement as to how customer deposits and final bills will be handled.
- (d) Proof of individual customer notice regarding discontinuance of service.
