By Order No. PSC-00-1924-CO-TI, issued October 19, 2000, consummating Order No. PSC-00-1691-PAA-TI, the Commission ordered Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI to credit customer bills beginning November 1, 2000, and ending November 30, 2000, for overcharging customers for 0+ intrastate toll calls placed from pay telephones and in call aggregator contexts between February 1, 1999, and January 12, 2000, remit any portion not refundable to the Commission for deposit in the State of Florida General Revenue Fund, and submit a final report in accordance with Rule 25-4.114, Florida Administrative Code. Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI remitted a check for \$787.20, the amount not refundable, with its final refund report to the Commission on February 27, 2001. Therefore, the Proceedings against Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI are complete and this docket should be closed administratively.
