RE: Item No. 39 - Docket No. 001440-WS - Application for authorization, pursuant to Rule 25-30.110(1)(b), Florida Administrative Code, to maintain accounting records outside the State of Florida, by AquaSource Utility, Inc., Ocala Oaks Utilities, Inc., Jasmine Lakes Utilities, Inc., Arredondo Utilities, Inc., Crystal River Utilities, Inc., and Lake Suzy Utilities, Inc.

On January 25, 2001, staff filed a recommendation in the above-referenced docket to approve the above-named utilities' request to keep their records out-of-state. Staff has since realized that staff has been delegated the authority to approve such requests of water and wastewater utilities "if the company agrees to reimburse the Commission for the reasonable travel expenses of the Commission's representative during any out-of-state audits or investigations." Section 2.07C., paragraph 10, Administrative Procedures Manual (APM). Because the above-named utilities have indicated that they will reimburse the Commission for such expenses, as necessary, staff wishes to withdraw the recommendation filed on January 25, 2001, in order to approve the utilities' request administratively.
