Issue 1: Should the joint petition filed by Sprint and BellSouth to modify certain exchange boundaries in Orange and Seminole counties and to amend the companies' certificates be approved?

Recommendation: Yes. The joint petition filed by Sprint and BellSouth should be approved because it meets the requirements of Section 364.335, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-4.005(1)(a)(b)(c) and 25-4.005(3), Florida Administrative Code, Transfer of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as to All or a Portion of Service Areas. The territory should be added to Certificate Number 22 (Sprint) and deleted from Certificate Number 8 (BellSouth).
