
Dear Jennifer:

This shall confirm our conversation earlier this week wherein I advised you that after several months of confusion as to where Mr. Viau's estate would be probated, i.e. Florida or Canada; it was determined that the probate of Mr. Viau's estate would take place in Canada. That process is now underway and I advised you that the estate of Henri Viau is the financially responsible party for the utility. I am advised that the estate has sufficient liquid assets and revenues to maintain the facility to the standards required by law. Sylvie Viau, daughter of Henri Viau, is serving as the executrix of the estate. Ms. Viau's mailing address is c/o Paul LeBlanc, Esq., McCarthy and Tetrault, 1170 Peel Street, Suite 500, Montreal, Canada H3B 4S8. Mr. LeBlanc is the Canadian attorney for the Viau estate. All correspondence concerning the estate and this proceeding should continue, as before, to be directed to me.
