


**VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL OF BELLSOUTH
TELECOMMUNICATIONS INC.'s PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE**

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, hereby voluntarily withdraws its Petition for Leave to Intervene in this proceeding, and as grounds therefore states:

1. On January 18, 2001 BellSouth filed a Petition for Leave to Intervene in this docket.
2. On March 28, 2001, this Commission issued a Proposed Agency Action granting in part Verizon Select Services, Inc.'s ("VSSI") waiver request but denying VSSI's request that the Florida Public Service Commission order BellSouth Telecommunication's, Inc. and Sprint-Florida, Inc. to provide basic local service to customers, who are currently provided alternative local service by VSSI, in BellSouth's and Sprint's franchise areas.
3. As a result of this decision, BellSouth wishes to voluntary dismiss its Petition for Leave to Intervene.


