Gulf Power Company (Gulf) has been filing certain confidential information as an attachment to its monthly earnings surveillance report pursuant to the requirements in Order No. PSC-96-1219-FOF-EI. Since the required information was not granted confidential status in that order, Gulf has filed requests for confidential classification of the information each month. The order required that the information be filed until such time as the Commercial/Industrial Service Rider Contract Service Agreement that was the basis of the information was reviewed and deemed prudent by the Commission.

Per Order No. PSC-01-0390-TRF-EI, issued February 15, 2001 (Consummating Order No. PSC-01-0617-CO-EI), Gulf's two existing contracts were found to be prudent. In addition, Gulf was relieved of any further obligation to provide the required confidential information related to the two existing contracts. Therefore, it is recommended that:

- 1) All previously received and retained information already classified as "confidential" be returned to Gulf:
- 2) All received information that is being held pending a ruling on its confidentiality be returned to Gulf; and
