Dear Ms. Bayo,

First, let me state it was not our intention to delay payment of our yearly assessment fee, the form or 2^{nd} notice sent to us, according to the letter from Paula Isler, were never received by me or our Accounting staff. My suspicion is that a newer member of our Corporate Office may have received it, and not knowing what to do with it, simply did nothing (t here are 140 people in our offices). This does not excuse us in any way, we should track the due date on this fee and contact you if it is not received, this is a mistake we will not repeat.

As instructed in a letter dated 4/3/01, and a follow up conversation with Paula Isler, below is my response to hopefully avoid any further action on your part to cancel our certificate. Enclosed is a check, calculated per the instructions on the Assessment Fee Return Form, which should resolve some part of our being late.

To prevent this problem from reoccurring we'd like to add a line to our address on the Assessment form, Stating "in care of Valerie Thibodeau or Roxanne Meadows", this should show below the State & zip portion of our address. Additionally, Roxanne Meadows and myself have already added an entry to our calendar for January 2002 to look for the form, and will contact the Public Service Commission if it fails to arrive at that time. Between the addition of our names to the form, and our scheduling to look for it in January should serve to resolve this to your satisfaction.

At this time, I am also waiving my objection to the administrative cancellation of our certificate in the event our offer is accepted, and we fail to comply with the terms we have offered.

I propose a settlement in the amount of \$250.00, with the hopes you will realize we were not malicious in intent not to pay our yearly fee, and are earnestly trying to remedy the situation and restore our certificate to good standing, as I think it was prior to this incident.

Dear Mrs. Thibodeau:

This is a follow up to our telephone conversation concerning the above docket. The regulatory assessment fee (RAF) is due each year by January 30 for the previous year, unless the 30th falls on a weekend, then the due date is the next working day. For example, the 2000 fee was due January 30, 2001.

Commission records show that as of this date, the 2000 RAF has not been paid. The 2000 RAF return is attached. Please complete and return it along with your check for the past due amount in full. The RAF is .0015% of your total Florida gross revenues, or \$50.00, whichever is greater. However, if you owe only the <u>minimum</u> amount and if it is postmarked by April 30, 2001, the 2000 total is \$59.00 (\$50.00 fee, \$7.50 penalty, and \$1.50 interest). If your check is postmarked between May 1 and May 30, 2001, the penalty increases to \$10.00 and the interest increases to \$2.00, or a total minimum amount of \$62.00.

Since the Commissioners have not yet voted on this docket, you have three options.

- (1) Cancel the certificate voluntarily Pay all past due charges in full, pay the current year's RAF or provide a date certain that it will be paid (such as 30 days from the date of the Commission Order cancelling your certificate), and write a letter requesting cancellation. A copy of our rule is attached.
- (2) Do nothing In this case, your certificate will be cancelled on the Commission's own motion. All outstanding RAFs, including penalty and interest charges, will be turned over to the Comptroller's Office for collection.
- (3) Propose a settlement There is normally a \$500 fine imposed for this rule violation. It should be noted that just paying the past due amount will not prevent

your certificate from being cancelled. You need to write the Commission a settlement letter that must include the following elements:

- Docket number;
- A check for the past due amount in full;
- A statement that it has taken steps to prevent future late payments of the regulatory assessment fees and what those steps are;
- A waiver of objection to the administrative cancellation of your certificate in the event your offer is accepted and you fail to comply with the terms which you have offered. All other elements of your previous settlement offers are reaffirmed; and
- Make a specific monetary settlement.

Any settlement offer should be addressed to Ms. Blanca Bayó, Director, Division of Records and Reporting, Florida Public Service Commission, 2540 Shumard Oak Blvd., Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850. The proposed settlement amount should <u>not</u> be paid at this time, instead only the past due regulatory assessment fee, plus penalty and interest charges should be paid. The settlement amount, if approved by the Commission, must be paid within 10 business days after the Commission Order is issued.

25-24.514 Cancellation of a Certificate.

(1) The Commission may cancel a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:

(a) Violation of the terms and conditions under which the authority was originally granted;

(b) Violation of Commission rules or orders;

(c) Violation of Florida Statutes; or,

(d) Failure to provide service for a period of six (6) months.

(2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request.

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(a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.

(b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.

(3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).
