ISSUE 1: Should the Commission grant Consumer Credit Assistance, Inc. a voluntary cancellation of Certificate No. 7371?

The Commission should cancel the company's Certificate No. 7371 on its own motion, effective on the date of issuance of the Consummating Order. The collection of the past due fees should be referred to the Office of the Comptroller for further collection efforts.
