## STATEMENT OF CHANGES

Rule 25-7.063(1) is changed to require testing of ten percent of the meters in a damaged shipping unit, such as a pallet or container, rather than ten percent of the meters in a damaged shipment. A pallet is the most common form of handling and moving a group of meters in shipment and normally contains less than 100 meters. Thus, when damage is limited to a single pallet of a shipment, only the meters in that pallet or container must be tested, and not all of the meters in an entire shipment.
