

IDS TELCOM'S PROPOSED LIST OF ISSUES

Issue 1: When IDS advertises or telemarkets its services, should IDS be allowed to use BellSouth's name as a "selling point?"

Issue 2: Should BellSouth be required to combine network elements that are not already combined at the particular location at which the network elements are requested by IDS when the 8th Circuit Court of Appeals has held that "it is not the duty of the ILECs to perform the functions necessary to combine unbundled network elements in any manner as required by the FCC's rules?"

Issue 3: When IDS is involved in a line splitting arrangement, should it pay BellSouth the sum of the recurring rates for an unbundled loop and an unbundled port plus the non-recurring charges associated with any work BellSouth must perform to accommodate the line splitting arrangement, or should it be allowed to pay UNE-P rates for an arrangement that is not a UNE-P?

Issue 4: If IDS disputes amounts that appear on a bill rendered by BellSouth, is it fair and reasonable to require IDS to explain which amounts it disputes and to document the reasons it disputes those amounts?
