RE: DOCKET NO. 010444-WU - Request for approval of tariff filing by Venture Associates Utilities Corp. in Marion County.

ISSUE 1: Should Venture's proposed tariff to reflect the current City of Ocala impact fee be approved?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Third Revised Tariff Sheet No. 38.0, filed on April 2, 2001, should be approved as filed. Within 20 days of the Commission's decision at agenda, the utility shall provide notice of the Commission's decision to all persons in the service area who are affected by the revised charges. The notice should be approved by Commission staff prior to distribution. The utility should provide proof that the appropriate customers or developers have received notice within ten days of the date of the notice. The tariff should become effective on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheets, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475, Florida Administrative Code.

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ISSUE 2: Should the docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. If Issue 1 is approved and there is no timely protest to the Commission's Order by a substantially affected person, the revised tariff sheets should become effective on or after the stamped approval date. If a protest is filed within 21 days of the issuance date of the Order, the tariff should remain in effect with the increase in the service availability charges held subject to refund pending resolution of the protest, and the docket should remain open. If no timely protest is filed, this docket should be closed upon the issuance of a Consummating Order.
