On behalf of Labrador Services, Inc., we will respond to your April 30, 2001 Inspection Report as follows in the order presented in your report:

PERMIT:

Mr. Viau's estate maintains control of Labrador Services, Inc., the permittee of record for the WWTP serving Forest Lake Estates in Zephyrhills Florida. Labrador Services, Inc. continues to own and operate the WWTP. The estate is administered by Mr. Viau's daughter whose name and address are set forth below:

RECORDS AND REPORTS:

- 1.A. I will confer with Ed Rogers, P.E., Zephyrhills, Florida, as to your position regarding the method of reporting calculated averaged results and will follow up in subsequent correspondence.
- 1.B. The January 2001 DMR is being corrected by the operator.
- No response required.
- 3. The engineering firm of Townsend and Rogers, Zephyrhills, Florida, has been retained to coordinate with Todd Hiscock, the plant operator, to review the current O&M manual and to revise it as necessary to meet the WWTP's current operation and maintenance requirements and the current facility configurations. I expect that a revised manual will be in place within thirty days.
- 4. The service and testing schedule for the auxiliary generator along with documentation that testing has been accomplished will be forwarded by the plant operator under separate cover.

FACILITY SITE REVIEW:

No response required.

FLOW MEASUREMENT:

- 1. Flow meter calibration information was handed to your secretary approximately two weeks ago by Mr. Hiscock. Please advise us if you do not have it in your possession.
- 2. This flow data comparison is in the operator's logbook. The operator is compiling this data in a separate report. The report should be submitted by the operator next week.

OPERATION & MAINTENANCE:

1. Regarding your comments as to clarifier surfaces, we note that no solids were going over the weir. Heavy loads due to seasonal occupancy were occurring at that time. In the summer off season, clarifiers are alternated and each clarifier is taken off line and scraped and repaired as necessary. That process is currently underway.

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- All clarifiers remain on line during the seasonal high occupancy periods. Now that the
 population in the community has seasonally declined, work is also under way to repair and
 maintain the clarifiers as needed. This process should be completed within one month.
- 3. The operator has advised me that the WWTP is now back to using three built-in chlorine contact chambers, thereby resolving this issue.

EFFLUENT QUALITY:

No response required.

OTHER:

We respectfully submit that the items set forth in your report have been or are being corrected and that the WWTP is operating in accordance with its permit.
