
Dear Ms. Isler:

I received your letter the other day and was very dismayed to find that this issue has not been resolved. I am forever hopeful that this will do it, as I don't want any "black marks" on our company name.

I wrote a letter to the commission (copy enclosed) on December 14, 1999, per F.A.C. regulations, canceling our certification. The pay telephones were removed from their locations on November 15, 1999 and we are now in federal litigation with the company that sold them to us. Having not heard anything from the commission since then, I assumed my letter was received and all was accepted. Then, in late February 2001, I received a delinquent notice (copy enclosed) and responded with a call to Jackie Knight who said she would look into the matter and call me back if she had any questions. She never called back, so again, I assumed that everything was in order.





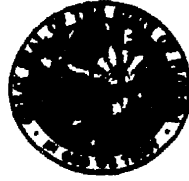

### Delinquent Notice

According to the Commission's records, we have not received payment for your 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee covering January 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000, which was due on January 30, 2001. If your RAF filing and payment are not received by March 7, 2001, your certificate may be canceled, and your account may be referred to the Commission's Division of Legal Services for appropriate action.

This is also to advise that pursuant to Florida Law, you shall add interest charges at 12% per annum, and a 5% penalty for each 30-day period or fraction thereof up to a maximum of 25%, in addition to the delinquent amount due. If you have paid your fees, please provide us with your check number and the date that it was paid. If you fail to comply within 15 days of this notice, the matter will be referred to our legal department to initiate enforcement proceedings which could result in either a fine or cancellation of the certificate or lien on your property.
