By Order No. PSC-01-1087-SC-TX, issued May 7, 2001, the Commission ordered Southern States Telephone, Inc. to remit a fine of \$10,000 in lieu of having Certificate No. 5694 canceled for apparent violation of Section 364.183(1), F.S., Access to Company Records. Southern States Telephone, Inc. failed to respond to the Order to Show Cause or remit the fine. Certificate No. 5694 was canceled in accordance with Order No. PSC-01-1087-SC-TX. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
