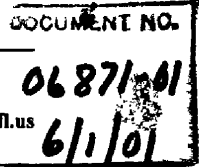
This is a follow up to your voice mail message and the copy of your 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) return and letter dated December 15, 2000 received via fax on May 24, 2001. I attempted to call you on May 25, but was unsuccessful in reaching you so I left a voice mail message. I decided to go ahead and write so that this docket can be resolved.

There are two kinds of cancellations. The first is voluntary, which is normally granted if the company is in good standing with the Commission and does not have a past due balance of the RAF, including statutory penalty and interest charges. The other is involuntary. If a company is **not** in good standing and has an outstanding balance of the RAF, the Commission normally cancels the certificate on its own motion for a rule violation. Any balance owed is forwarded to the Comptroller's Office for collection.

The regulatory assessment fee is assessed if a certificate is active for any one day during a calendar year. The RAF is due by January 30 of each year for the preceding calendar year, unless the 30th falls on a weekend, then the fee is due by the next working day. If payment of the RAF is mailed after the due date, then statutory penalty and interest charges are applicable.

The effective date of a voluntary cancellation is the date that the Commission received a company's request for cancellation. In this case, your letter is dated December 15, 2000, therefore, the company owes the 2000 RAF, even if the company is no longer in business or, in fact, never went into business.

This means that Notae owes the minimum \$50 RAF, plus \$12.50 penalty and \$2.50 interest, for a total of \$65.00. That is the amount owed if payment is postmarked by June 29, 2001. The interest continues to accrue until the RAF is paid. It should be noted that any unpaid RAF, including



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penalty and interest charges, will be turned over to the Comptroller's Office for further collection efforts.

In order for me to recommend a voluntary cancellation, Notae needs to provide the Commission with the following (we must receive a hard copy with an original signature -- faxed filings are not accepted):

- A letter referencing the docket number and explaining that you previously requested cancellation of Notae's Pay Telephone Certificate No. 4360;
- A copy of Notae's 2000 RAF return;
- A copy of your December 15, 2000 letter requesting cancellation of your certificate; and
- Payment for the 2000 RAF, including statutory penalty and interest charges.

Once the above is received, I will write a recommendation to grant Notae a voluntary cancellation with an effective date of December 15, 2000. Otherwise, I will have no choice except to recommend denial of your request for a voluntary cancellation and recommend that Notae's certificate be cancelled on the Commission's own motion. Please respond in writing by June 15, 2001, and let me know how you wish to proceed. In the meantime, if you have any questions, just let me know.
