**MOTION FOR ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 554  
AUTHORIZING THE DEBTOR TO ABANDON CERTAIN  
PERSONAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE ESTATE**

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §554 and Rule 6007 of Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the debtor, Commco Technology L.L.C. d/b/a BroadStream Communications Corporation (the "Debtor" and/or "Commco") respectfully seeks from this Court an order authorizing it to abandon certain personal property belonging to the estate. In support of this motion, the Debtor represents the following:

1. On December 18, 2000 (the "Petition Date"), Commco filed with this Court a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
2. Commco is continuing to operate its business and manage its property as a Debtor-in-Possession pursuant to §§1107 and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code.

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3. A committee of unsecured creditors was appointed by the office of the United States Trustee on February 1, 2001, which appointment was thereafter amended on February 9, 2001.

4. No examiner has been appointed or designated herein.

5. Immediately prior to the commencement of this Chapter 11 case, Commco closed two (2) out-of-state offices and consolidated all business and financial operations from its third and remaining office at Two Stamford Plaza, 281 Tresser Boulevard in Stamford, Connecticut, also the Debtor's principal place of business. In connection with the (2) office closings and subsequent business consolidations, all staff members were laid off. The office supplies (scotch tape, paper clips, staples, post-it notes) purchased for use by the Debtor's former employees are located at the Debtor's principal place of business in Stamford, Connecticut and have remained there since the commencement of this case.

6. On June 12, 2001, an emergency hearing was held before this Court on the Debtor's motion to employ Bid4Assets, Inc. to liquidate at auction certain personal property belonging to the Debtor which property is also housed at Two Stamford Plaza, 281 Tresser Boulevard in Stamford, Connecticut, the Debtor's principal place of business. The auction is expected to occur before the end of June, 2001.

7. Prior to the auction, however, the Debtor would like to assemble and donate the aforementioned office supplies that have de minimis value and not marketability to a worthy cause. Specifically, the Debtor would like to donate these items to the 399th Combat Support Hospital in Kosovo which, while working along with the Task Force Medical Falcon IV, is collecting any and all supplies for the schools and orphanages that have been devastated by the conflict in Kosovo. Although the office supplies are of no consequential value or benefit to the estate, they will certainly be of consequential value to the school children and orphans of Kosovo. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a list of the office supplies.

WHEREFORE, Commco respectfully requests that this Court enter an order authorizing the Debtor to abandon the personal property (office supplies) set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto so that the Debtor can donate those items to the 399th Combat Support Hospital in Kosovo.
