Dear Mr. Amos:

We are in receipt of your letter regarding the application filed by Breeze Hill Utility-Bieber Enterprises d/b/a Terrance Hartigh in the above-referenced docket. According to your letter, you wish to object to the transfer until such time as you are more fully aware of "all points and ramifications of such."

As discussed in our telephone conversation of June 14, 2001, a transfer of majority organizational control involves the transfer of control of a utility usually through the transfer of stock. In this case, control is passing from Mr. Bieber to Mr. Terrance Hartigh. Otherwise, the transfer does not affect service or rates and charges, which cannot be changed without prior Commission approval and notice to the customers. The utility's last rate increase was granted by Order No. PSC-99-2394-FOF-WS, issued December 7, 1999, in Docket No. 990356-WS. Those approved rates will not change as a result of the application for transfer of control filed in this Docket.

The Commission needs to know your intent regarding your objection to this application. If you choose to pursue the objection, a hearing will be scheduled in which you will be required to provide testimony and other evidence to support your protest. Although the Commission allows individuals to represent themselves at hearing, you may wish to hire an attorney to represent you.

Please advise this Commission by July 6, 2001, if you intend to pursue your objection and request a hearing. Your request should be made in writing and should be addressed to Blanca Baye,
