**RE: America's Tele-Network - Final Revised Report on Settlement Compliance
Ordered by PSC-01-1035-AS-TP regarding Dockets 001066 and 001813**

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Ladies and Gentlemen:

This document serves to provide the Florida Public Service Commission ("PSC") with the comprehensive notice of settlement compliance requested by staff and ordered by PSC Order PSC-01-1035-AS-TP dated April 27, 2001. This text supersedes the previous filings of May 10 and June 13, 2001 regarding specific compliance information as provided in conformity with the above order. This writing also incorporates the explanations provided in the documents federal expressed to the Commission on May 10 and June 13, 2001 respectively, regarding the company's efforts at substantial compliance with the settlement agreement. America's Tele-Network ("AT-N" or "Company") respectfully requests that the Commission close the docket for this proceeding.

As its attorneys emphasized in the correspondence of May 10 and June 13, 2001 and in a telephone conversation with PSC staff on May 15, 2001, AT-N again affirms that it substantially complied with its obligations in a timely fashion. Further, the company maintains that it is now and has since June 1, 2001, been in complete compliance with the settlement agreement outlined in the PSC order of April 27, 2001.

A history of the Company's compliance is outlined below:

- The Company did not object to the involuntary cancellation of its Certificate Nos. 4377 and 4834 on April 27, 2001.
- The Florida complaints set forth in Docket Nos. 001066 and 001813

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have been satisfactorily resolved with full compensation given to the customers for the disputed amounts. As staff is aware, some of these complaints did not involve AT-N. These complaints were investigated and referred to the proper sources when possible. Another full listing of the settlements of these complaints is attached.

- The Company ceased operations in the state on May 31, 2001, after providing written notification to its few remaining customers.
- The Company never actively provided ALEC service under its certificate and thus never acquired an underlying carrier. The Company did utilize a number of underlying carriers for its IXC service, using Qwest in this regard most recently until its termination of operations in Florida.

Based upon the above representations, the Company respectfully reiterates its request that the Commission close Dockets 001066 and 001813.
