## **CITIZENS' PREHEARING STATEMENT**

The Citizens of the State of Florida, through their attorney, the Public Counsel, in

conformance with Order No. PSC-01-0517-PCO-EI, hereby file this prehearing statement.

## A. WITNESSES:

The Citizens do not intend to call any witnesses to testify.

## **B. EXHIBITS:**

The Citizens do not intend to use any exhibits.

## C. STATEMENT OF BASIC POSITION

Retail customers are supporting all the assets used for non-separated wholesale sales and are thus entitled to the proceeds from such sales. The Commission has adopted a formula to split the gains between the IOU's and their customers, but the split was adopted only for the explicit purpose of maximizing the off-system sales for the benefit of the retail ratepayers. Accordingly, any implementation procedure must be consistent with the stated purpose of benefitting the retail customers.

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FPSC-RECORDS/REPORTING

ISSUE 1:	What is the appropriate regulatory treatment for Gulf Power Company's $SO_2$ emission allowances associated with its non-separated wholesale energy sales?
OPC POSITION:	Within its own context, the regulatory treatment sought by Gulf is reasonable. The Citizens are concerned, however, with any disparate applications of generic principles.
ISSUE 2:	What is the appropriate regulatory treatment for the cost of fuel and purchased power associated with non-separated wholesale energy sales?
OPC POSITION:	The treatment should assure that retail customers will never incur financial

- disadvantages from transactions involving retail assets. To achieve this end, the cost of non-separated wholesale sales should be removed from the retail cost recovery clause(s) on an incremental basis. For this purpose "incremental" should be considered as the highest cost fuel burned or power purchased during the hour that the respective wholesale sale was transacted.
- ISSUE 3: What is the appropriate regulatory treatment for the operation and maintenance (O&M) expenses associated with non-separated wholesale energy sales?
- OPC POSITION: No position at this time.

G. STIPULATED ISSUES: The Citizens are not aware of any issues that have been stipulated at this time.

H. PENDING MOTIONS: The Citizens are not seeking action on any motion or other matter pending at this time.

I. PENDING REQUESTS OR CLAIMS FOR CONFIDENTIALITY: The Citizens have no requests for confidentiality.

J. STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE: The Citizens are not aware of any requirement of Order No. PSC-01-0517-PCO-EI with which the Citizens cannot comply.
