When staff opened Docket Nos. 991930-TP and 001762-TC, we believed that we were ready to recommend rule amendments to the Commission for proposal pursuant to Section 120.54, Florida Statutes. After the rule development workshops, however, staff discovered that it had opened the docket prematurely, and that rule amendments should not be proposed at this time. No recommendation has been filed, and no Commission action has been taken on these rules. Thus, Docket Nos. 991930-TP and 001762-TP were opened erroneously and should be closed. Closing this docket is consistent with APM 2.07 C.5.a., which allows the Director of the Division of Records and Reporting to administratively close dockets that were erroneously opened.
