On May 29, 2001, the First District Court of Appeal issued its Opinion affirming Order No. PSC-98-0143-FOF-WS. Mandate was issued on June 11, 2001. No appeal was taken of this opinion, and the time for filing an appeal has passed.

Moreover, the refund required by Order No. PSC-98-0143-FOF-WS to the Spring Hill customers was disposed of through the Commission's approval of the Settlement Agreement Extension in Order No. PSC-01-0387-AS-WS, issued February 15, 2001. Therefore, pursuant to Order No. PSC-98-0143-FOF-WS, there are no further actions to be taken in this docket, and this docket may be closed.
