PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT petitioning creditor Newton & Associates, Inc., ("Newton") will bring on for hearing, at the time and place set forth below, a motion for approval of a settlement of its claims against alleged debtor Tradex International, Inc., ("Tradex"), and to dismiss this involuntary bankruptcy proceeding.

Background: Newton and Tradex arbitrated a dispute between them. An arbitration award was entered on November 15, 2000. The arbitration award provided that Tradex would pay Newton \$44,000 and return certain computer equipment. A dispute arose regarding enforcement of the arbitration award. Newton commenced this involuntary proceeding. Tradex has strongly contested the appropriateness of the involuntary petition and sought an award of costs, attorneys fees, damages and punitive damages.

Newton and Tradex agreed to resolve the various disputes between them. Tradex will pay Newton \$35,841.71, which includes a credit of approximately \$10,000 in lieu of returning the computer equipment, and \$1,000 to satisfy a separate claim against Tradex recently acquired by Newton. Newton will return a Dell 2300 server to Tradex. Each party shall be responsible for its own costs and attorneys fees incurred herein.

FURTHER INFORMATION is contained in the written motion and agreement which have been filed with the Clerk of the Court, or may be obtained by contacting counsel for Newton at the address set forth below.
