Dear Sir:

I would like to record my objection to the proposed certification of King's Point Utility, Inc. P.O. Box 420521, Kissimmee, FL 34742, to provide water and waste water service to the property described in a notice dated July 6, 2001.

I am objecting to the certification based upon the past history of the utility and persons associated with the management of the utility, and who to my understanding, are involved with the current certification process.

When the water and sewage system had been operated by King's Point Utility, Inc., the system was poorly maintained resulting in frequent disruptions of water service. In addition, residents served by King's Point Utility, Inc. had to boil water due to high bacteria counts. In a public meeting held at the local Elks Club, management of the utility expressed little concern for the state of the utility and showed a lack or concern for the health of residence including those with immune system deficiencies.

I am not convinced that King's Point Utility, Inc. will be able to provide the level of service that we now experience with the current provider, Kissimmee Utility Authority. I therefore hope you will deny this application for certification by King's Point Utility, Inc.
