Dear Mr. and Mrs. Johnson:

Thank you for your letter of July 19, 2001, regarding the application filed in the above-referenced docket. In your letter, you indicated that you object to Mr. Walter Medlin regaining control of the utility and providing service to your area because of his past record of running the utility. You also expressed concern regarding a possible rate increase.

According to the information provided in the application, at the time the City of Kissimmee became receiver of the utility, the utility systems were dismantled and interconnected to the City's systems. Currently, the utility only consists of a wastewater collection system including one lift station, and a water distribution system. Kings Point Utility, Inc. proposes to purchase potable water and wastewater service from the City of Kissimmee. Therefore, the City of Kissimmee will provide bulk water and wastewater service to the utility and the utility will provide these same water and wastewater services to you.

This Commission will consider your concerns when reviewing the application to determine if the granting of certificates to Kings Point Utility, Inc. is in the public interest. As part of that review, the Commission will evaluate all information to determine what the appropriate rates are for the utility. However, the Commission needs to know your intent regarding your objection to this application. If you choose to pursue the objection, a hearing will be scheduled in which you will be required to provide testimony and other evidence to support your protest. Although the Commission allows individuals to represent themselves at hearing, you may wish to hire an attorney to represent you.

Please advise this Commission by August 10, 2001, if you intend to pursue your objection and request a hearing. Your request should be made in writing and should be addressed to Blanca

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
