VoiceStream Wireless ("VoiceStream"), by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, respectfully petitions the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for leave to intervene and permit VoiceStream to participate in this proceeding as a party of record, affording it all applicable rights under Florida law and the rules of the Commission. - 3. VoiceStream is a facilities based commercial mobile radio service ("CMRS") provider that utilizes NXX codes in the provision of a full panapoly of wireless telecommunications services throughout Florida.
- 4. In In re: Investigation of Proposed Updates to the Routing Data Base System (RDBS) and Business Rating Input Data Base System (BRIDS) Affecting the Tampa Telecommunications Carriers, Docket No. 010102, the Commission asked the parties in that proceeding to address the Commission's authority to order rate center consolidation.
- 5. In Order No. PSC-01-1577-FOF-TP, issued July 31, 2001 in Docket No. 010102-TP, the Commission deferred its determination concerning the Commission's authority to order rate center consolidation, and because of the broad statewide impact of the matter, ordered Commission staff to expeditiously open the instant docket to enable the Commission to conduct a more focused analysis of the legal and technical aspects of rate center consolidation.
- 6. This proceeding will focus on a host of legal, factual and policy issues concerning the consolidation of rate centers, including the extent of the Commission's authority to order rate center consolidation pursuant to state and federal law, and the impact of rate center consolidation on Florida's telecommunications providers, including the availability and accessibility of NXX codes. As a facilities based CMRS provider in Florida, VoiceStream utilizes a significant number

of NXX codes and its business interests, including but not limited to the timely availability of NXX codes, will be significantly impacted by any decision the Commission may render regarding rate center consolidation. Thus, the Commission's decisions in this proceeding, which are anticipated to have general applicability, affect VoiceStream's substantial interests, entitling VoiceStream to participate with party status as a matter of law.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, VoiceStream respectfully requests that it be granted intervention as a full party in this proceeding.
