Re: Docket No. 990649-TP, Investigation into Pricing of Unbundled Network Elements

To All Parties:

On July 9, 2001, Commission Staff held a scheduling conference with the parties in this docket. At that conference, the parties agreed that Verizon would withdraw the cost studies and testimony it filed on May 18, 2001. The parties and Staff have agreed to a November 7, 2001 filing date for updated studies and testimony.

During the scheduling conference, Staff asked Verizon and Sprint to provide the existing native files related to the development of inputs for their cost models. Verizon's counsel noted that Verizon was already working with Staff to identify the native files to be produced (essentially, those that are in spreadsheet format, rather than those that only exist in .PDF format, catalog pages, and the like.)

At the scheduling conference, certain parties asked for these native files, as well. Specifically, in exchange for their agreeing to the November 7 filing date for Verizon's cost studies and testimony, parties have asked Verizon to produce the native files at that time. These files will relate to Verizon's updated study to be filed on November 7. Verizon agrees to provide these files to Staff and to parties that request them and execute the appropriate protective agreements.

In addition to the files relating to the updated study, parties have asked Verizon to produce the native files underlying the inputs in Verizon's study filed on May 18, which has been withdrawn. They indicate that review of such files will help them to understand Verizon's model, so that they can complete their review of Verizon's November 7 filing more quickly.

Verizon will provide to the parties the existing native files for the withdrawn recurring cost study on the following conditions: (1) these files are not part of the evidentiary record in this case; (2) no party will attempt to introduce any portion of these files into the record; (3) no party shall serve any discovery requests that relate to or rely upon the files; (4) no

party shall engage in any cross-examination that relates to or relies upon the files; and (5) Verizon will provide the files to each requesting party 30 days from the date of its signing this letter. Verizon notes that it has already provided the native files for the nonrecurring charge study filed on May 18, 2001.
