Dear Mr. McGurrin:

This is a follow up to our telephone conversation concerning Docket No. 010716-TI, which was established for nonpayment of the 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF). As background information, the RAF is due each year by January 30 for the previous year, unless the 30th falls on a weekend, then the due date is the next working day. For example, the 1999 fee was due January 31, 2000 and the 2000 fee was due by January 30, 2001.

Commission records show that as of this date, the 2000 RAF has not been paid. The 2000 RAF return is attached. Please complete and return it along with payment for the past due amount in full, including penalty and interest charges. The RAF is .0015% of the company's total Florida gross revenues, or \$50.00, whichever is greater. The interest charge continues to accrue until paid.

This is the second docket in two years that the Commission has established for the same rule violation. The prior docket was No. 001209-TI, which was established for nonpayment of the 1999 RAF. In that docket, the company proposed to pay a settlement of \$100 and pay future RAFs on a timely basis. The Commission accepted the company's proposal, the \$100 settlement was paid, and the docket was closed.

Since you indicated in our conversation that the company wishes to keep its certificate active and since the Commissioners have not yet voted on this docket, the company should propose a settlement. It should be noted that just paying the past due amount will not prevent the company's certificate from being cancelled. All settlements should include the following elements:

- Docket number;
- A check for the past due amount in full;

- A statement that the company has taken steps to prevent future late payments of the regulatory assessment fees, what those steps are, and why the steps the company advised were taken in the prior docket did not work;
- A waiver of objection to the administrative cancellation of the company's certificate in the event its offer is accepted and it fails to comply with the terms which it has offered. If, however, there is a factual dispute as to the manner or level of compliance with any provision in the settlement, Commission staff will bring the matter to the Commission for consideration; and
- Make a specific monetary settlement. There is normally a \$1,000 fine imposed when two dockets have been opened for the same rule violation. However, in other similar cases, the Commission has accepted settlement amounts less than the fine amount.

Any settlement offer/correspondence should be addressed to Ms. Blanca Bayó, Director, Division of the Commission Clerk & Administrative Services, Florida Public Service Commission, 2540 Shumard Oak Blvd., Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850. The proposed settlement amount should not be paid at this time, instead only the past due regulatory assessment fee, plus penalty and interest charges should be paid. The settlement amount, if approved by the Commission, must be paid within 10 business days after the Commission Order is issued.
