**IDS TELCOM LLC'S NOTICE OF INTENT
TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

IDS Telecom, L.L.C. (hereinafter "IDS"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006,
Florida Administrative Code, files this its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential
Classification.

1. On August 24, 2001, IDS filed its Notice of Service of Supplemental
Responses to BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.'s Interrogatories Nos. 1 – 103
and hand delivered a copy of the IDS' Supplemental Responses to BellSouth's
Interrogatories Nos. 1 – 103 to BellSouth's Miami Office. The confidential
information contained within some of these Responses is protected by a
Protective Agreement entered into by IDS and BellSouth on August 23, 2001.




