Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) filed a petition for mid-course adjustment to its fuel factors on Thursday, August 23, 2001. Within its petition, FPL requested consideration of the matters contained therein at the Commission's September 4, 2001 Agenda. FPL's petition includes a proposal to decrease its 2001 fuel factors by \$138.1 million from October through December 2001. The expedited consideration is requested by FPL so that the proposed adjustments may be in effect for three complete billing cycles at the revised rate. In the event that the expedited consideration is not allowed, the Company implies that the proposed rate decrease would not be available for all of the three billing cycles.

In addition, Florida Power Users Group (FIPUG) filed a petition on Wednesday, August 15, 2001 to reduce the fuel factors for the October through December 2001 billing cycles for FPL, Florida Power Corporation (FPC), and Tampa Electric Company (TECO). FIPUG requests that the factors be reduced to the levels originally authorized by Order PSC -00-2385-FOF-EI in Docket No. 010001-EI for the year 2001. FIPUG requested consideration of its petition at the September 4, 2001 Agenda.

Staff did not file its recommendation for the FIPUG petition for the September 4, 2001 Agenda, since latitude was given to consider the petition at the September 18, 2001 Agenda by the prehearing officer in the docket (Commissioner Jaber). However, since the FIPUG and FPL petitions are interrelated, such that one cannot be reasonably resolved in isolation from the other, it is imperative that they be considered at the same agenda conference. Since FPL's petition represents that delay in consideration of its petition would result in some level of delay in its proposed rate reductions, the two petitions should be considered at the September 4, 2001 Agenda.

Given the fact that the FPL's petition was not filed until after the recommendation filing deadline for the September 4, 2001 Agenda, staff does not have a recommendation prepared at this time. Staff will file its recommendation on both the FPL petition and the FIPUG petition by 4:00 PM on Wednesday, August ~~28~~, 2001.
