Recommendation concerning Tampa Electric Company's (TECO) Request for confidential classification of Document Nos. 05470-01, 05471-01, 05472-01, 05473-01.

The above-referenced documents are deposition transcripts of TECO witnesses Ashburn, Rodriguez, Sweat, and Westra. On May 1, 2001, TECO requested confidential classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 366.093, Florida Statutes of the information contained in the documents.

Exhibit A of TECO's confidentiality request lists the pages and lines for which TECO seeks confidential classification. In addition, TECO provides in Exhibit A the rationale for its confidentiality request for each page and line.
