3. The Commission granted Time Warner a certificate of authority in Docket No. 95-0906 to provide services as an Alternative Local Exchange Company ("ALEC") in Florida. Time Warner is a facilities-based competitive carrier presently providing exchange access and local exchange telecommunications services in Florida. Accordingly, Time Warner is subject to the rules, regulations, and orders of the Commission, and such rules, regulations, and orders impact Time Warner in the provision of telecommunications services in Florida, and Time Warner's ability to compete. Thus, the interests of Time Warner Telecom may or will be substantially affected by any decision regarding anti-competitive practices of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.

For the reasons stated above, Time Warner respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Petition for Leave to Intervene and accord Time Warner full party status in this proceeding.


