Dear Ms. Bayó:

In reference to the foregoing docket, please find FairPoint's payment of its Year 2000 RAF, including the statutory penalty and interest charges, in the amount of \$619.96.

Pursuant to Paula Isler's letter to Michael Kent dated August 15, 2001, FairPoint also proposes a monetary settlement of \$300.00 in lieu of full payment of the maximum \$500.00 fine. FairPoint has updated its accounting system to ensure that the RAF associated with FairPoint's certification as a toll provider in Florida will be timely paid on a "go forward" basis. FairPoint observes that it timely paid the RAF associated with its status as a local service provider in Florida. However, the RAF associated with FairPoint's status as a toll provider in Florida was overlooked for the reason that in other states in which FairPoint is operational only a single assessment is generally due—CLECs such as FairPoint which offer both local and local toll or long distance services are typically not separately certificated in these states. Again, FairPoint's accounting system has been modified accordingly.

FairPoint further waives its right to object to administrative cancellation of FairPoint's certificate in the event its offer is accepted and FairPoint subsequently fails to comply with the proposed settlement terms.
