In discussing with staff yesterday, the procedure for getting into the record additional data that we feel is of the utmost importance in staff's determinations in writing its recommendations for the Commissioners to consider, I was instructed to direct to your office a "Request for Deferment".


By way of this letter I am asking you as Chairman of the Florida Public Service to allow us an additional two weeks to get into staff's hand the supplemental information that we would like for them to consider before writing their final recommendation for you and the other Commissioners to vote on.

I attach a copy of the CASR for this Docket and ask that you please take note of the dates indicated on it. Staff Recommendation is scheduled for December, 2001, The PAA is scheduled for January, 2002, and Closing the Docket is scheduled for February, 2002. I fully understand that all of these dates are tentative and subject to change but I submit to you that Utilities, Inc. who just sold out to NUON of the Netherlands for \$400 million in cash(copy attached) has an unfair advantage and can muster any number of attorneys and accountants they desire, and we cannot afford to hire one attorney. Also, we just received the Recommendation day before yesterday(Monday), and it is scheduled for agenda next Tuesday, the fourth of September.

Chairman Jacobs, we were caught off guard when we received the Staff's Recommendation four months early as scheduled by the CASR. We have been in the process of going through our

records and gathering other data that we felt was very important for Staff to review before writing their final recommendation. We humbly ask that you consider our request favorably and give us a few more days to get these documents to Staff and allow them time to review them.

Dutch to buy Utilities Inc.

NORTHBROOK, IL - Utilities Inc. has agreed to be acquired by Nuon, a provider of electricity, gas and water headquartered in the Netherlands, for \$400 million in cash.

According to a spokesman for Utilities Inc., the company will retain its current management and name. The transaction has not yet been approved by the company's 400-some shareholders, but the spokesman said approval is expected within the next month.

Carel W.J. Kok, chief growth Officer for Nuon, said the acquisition of Utilities Inc. is consistent with his employer's international growth strategy in the Netherlands, Germany and the United States.
