After reviewing the application in the above referenced docket, staff identified the following deficiencies. Please correct and provide the information as requested.

- 1. As required by Rule 25-30.034(1)(d), Florida Administrative Code, the applicant is required to provide a statement regarding the applicant's financial ability to continue to provide service. The application included proforma financial statements for the year ending December 31, 2000, that were prepared by the City of Kissimmee. Please provide the financial statements for the most recent twelve month period ending July 31, 2001, that reflects the utility's finances versus projected information from the City of Kissimmee. If the utility's financial information is not available, the owner of the utility may provide personal financial statements.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.034(l)(e) Florida Administrative Code, evidence of ownership of the land, or continued use of the land such as a 99-year lease, should be included in the application. The application included a lease for land with William R. Wright, Trustee, which only has 29 years remaining. Provide either a lease pursuant to the Rule, or explain why Kings Point Utility, Inc. is unable to provide such a lease.
